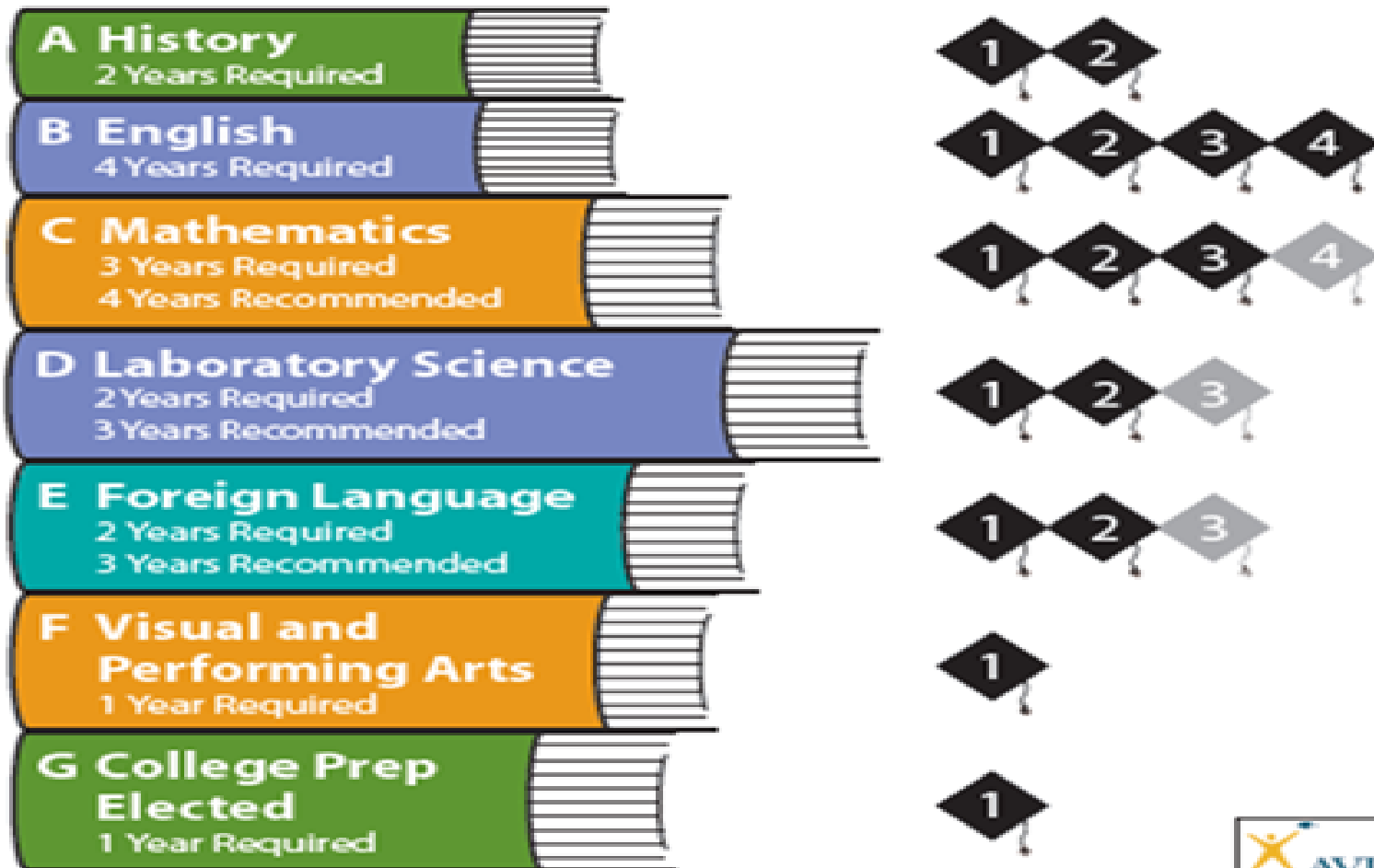
# What are A-G Requirements?

- ✓ Must be passed with a grade of 'C' or better.

## DIVISION 1

- 16 Core Courses
- 4 years of English
- 3 years of math (Algebra 1 or higher)
- 2 years of natural/physical science (1 year of lab if offered by high school)
- 1 year of additional English, math or natural/physical science
- 2 years of social science
- 4 years of additional courses (from any area above, foreign language or comparative religion/philosophy)

## DIVISION 2

- 16 Core Courses
- 3 years of English
- 2 years of math (Algebra 1 or higher)
- 2 years of natural/physical science (1 year of lab if offered by high school)
- 3 years of additional English, math or natural/physical science
