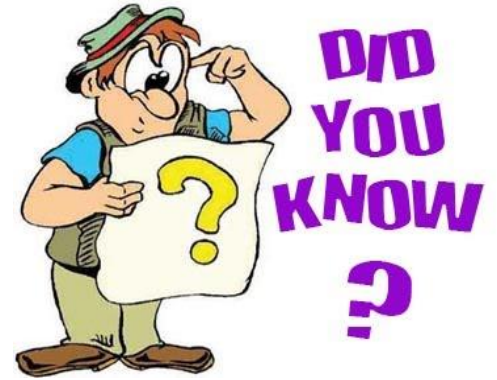

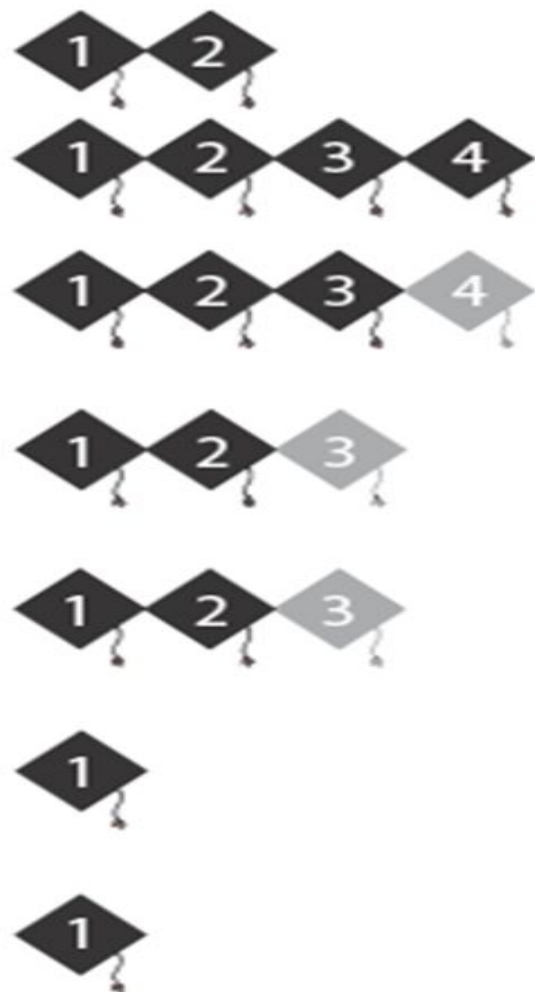

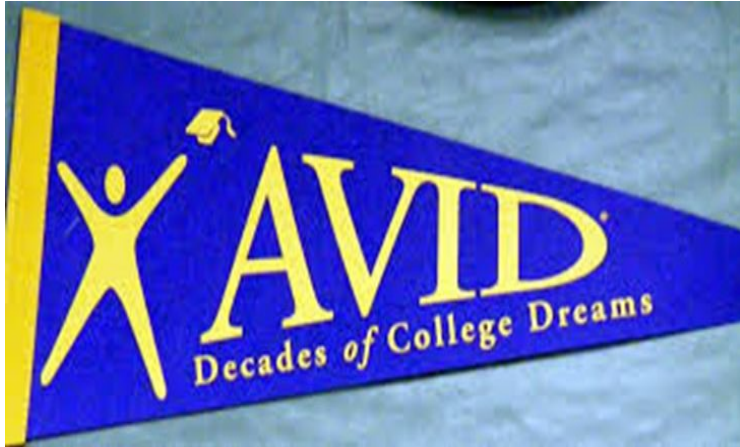
Sequence of High School Courses

Career Technical Education

CTE is a program of study that involves a multiyear sequence of courses that integrate core academic knowledge with technical and occupational knowledge to provide students with a pathway to postsecondary education and careers. TUSD's and FHS College and Career Pathways provide opportunities for students to learn skills that will serve them in a variety of post-secondary endeavors. By allowing students to add hands-on learning to an already strong core academic program, they will graduate from high school prepared to lead at the next level.

Q&A

Do I still need to complete A-G requirements if I attend a community college?

Although A-G is not a requirement for community college, A-G courses will prepare you for expectations at either a 4-year college or a community college. Preparing for college and career readiness will give the tools to succeed for postsecondary education and a career.

What might be another way to acquire skills that can lead to a career?

CTE Pathways are designed to serve students with hands-on courses for today's careers. FHS offers nine different career technical education pathways.

What is the difference in cost and earning a degree between community college versus four-year university?

At the community college you can earn a two-year degree, Associate of Arts/Science degree which is needed to transfer to four-year university. Attending a four-year university you can earn a Bachelor of Art/Science degree and higher. Whether you attend a community college or a university each will prepare you for a future career. Tuition at a four-year university tends to be more expensive, however financial aid is available for both programs and grants are awarded based on need and the cost of the college. Scholarships, student work programs, and loans are available through financial aid.

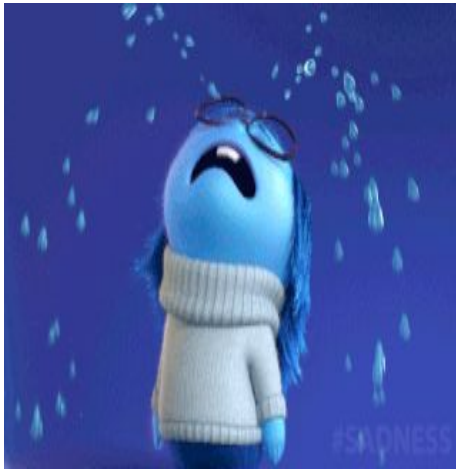
