

IMPACTION at CSU FULLERTON

LOCAL AREA

Local admissions area freshmen and transfer students will need to present a strong academic record, with appropriate courses and grades and good SAT or ACT scores (FTF only).

Local area **freshman applicants** are high school graduates in Orange County, Chino, Corona/Norco, Walnut, Whittier, and Alvord School Districts.

Local area transfer applicants come from community colleges in Orange County.






