- Take SAT/ACT
- Complete A-G Coursework
- Meet Eligibility Index

TRANSFER

- Good Academic Standing
- 60 Transferable Units
- Golden Four
 - Oral Communications
 - Written Communications
 - Math/Quantitative Reasoning
 - Critical Thinking
- Meet GPA cut-off

IMPACTION at CSU FULLERTON

LOCAL AREA

Local admissions area freshmen and transfer students will need to present a strong academic record, with appropriate courses and grades and good SAT or ACT scores (FTF only).

Local area **freshman applicants** are high school graduates in Orange County, Chino, Corona/Norco, Walnut, Whittier, and Alvard School Districts.

Local area **transfer applicants** come from community colleges in Orange County.

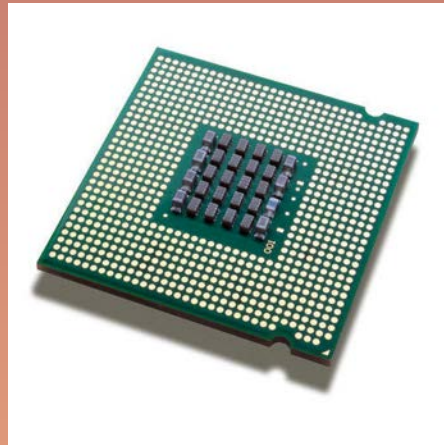

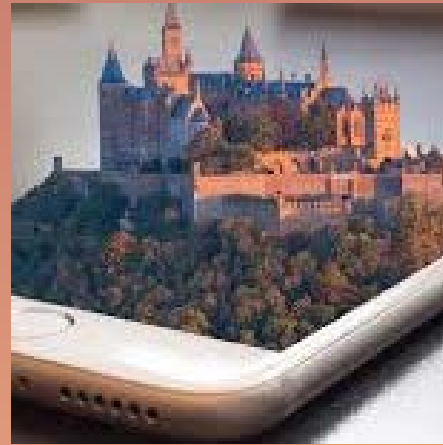
