When is registration for AP exams?

9/1/19 - 11/1/19 online at www.totalregistration.net/AP/053234

Are there refunds?

Refunds of \$100 (or \$10 for reduced fee) per exam are available if exams are canceled before 11/1/19.

Can non-FHS students sign up to take an exam at Foothill?

If we are offering the exam being requested, have space available, AND the student resides within TUSD district boundaries, yes. Approval is through Dr. Hartloff.

How much do exams cost?

\$105 per exam if you register by 11/1/19. For registration after 11/1/19, exam fees increase to \$150 per exam, INCLUDING Free/Reduced Lunch Program students.

How do I know if I will qualify for a reduced exam fee?

If you participate in the Free/Reduced Lunch Program, the online system will notify the school, and Dr. Hartloff will give approval for the fee reduction. If you do not participate in the program, you will need to apply in order for a fee reduction to be approved. The reduced fee is \$15 per exam.

When are AP exams?

5/4/20 - 5/15/20. Morning exams begin promptly at 7:30 AM and afternoon exams begin at 12:00 PM. The date of each exam is pre-determined by the College Board and cannot be modified or adjusted by individual school sites. Every school giving AP exams will administer them in this window.

What exams does Foothill offer?

FHS only offers exams for the AP courses offered at the school. See schedule on next page.

What if I am unable to take the exam on this date?

The reason for the late exam must fall under certain qualifications set by College Board. Late testing must be approved by Dr. Hartloff. All late exams occur 5/20/20-5/22/20.

Who is my homeroom teacher when I am completing the form on Total Registration?

Your fourth period teacher is considered your homeroom teacher.
