



- Review your final college list with your family to make sure it fits your career choice and finances. Add or make changes on your Naviance college list
 "colleges I am considering" Use the scattergram on your Naviance account to see how your GPA match up to the colleges you have selected You can also go
 on CollegeBoard and use their college search. SAT and ACT is optional this year for Cal States and UC Schools and not part of your evaluation If you want
 to try the SAT or ACT, sign up for the October test SAT or ACT
- Check <u>@fhscollegeandcareer</u> Instagram account for virtual college visits and college information Complete your Brag Sheet for your teachers and counselor for letters of recommendation <u>Brag Sheet</u>
- Counselors will be making college presentation that will help you to complete your applications. Recheck your A-G requirements. Attend the College
 Application Night (on hold for 2020) Representatives from UC, CSU, Community Colleges and Common Application will be reviewing the application process.
 Stay in touch with our college and career counselor, Hannah Huynh hhuynh@tustin.k12.ca.us for college workshops and update.
- Check the counseling calendar for the schedule of admission representatives visiting FHS and sign up for colleges of interest. If you cannot attend a specific visit, fill out an interest card in the College & Career Center for the college representative.
- Fill out your brag sheet on Naviance. Copy and paste it onto a Word document and increase the font to 12 pt. to give to your teachers that are writing your letter of recommendation. You may want to include a thank you card or note. Inform your counselor that you will be applying to a private school and will need them to complete your secondary school report and write a letter of recommendation. Make sure that your brag sheet is updated. Your counselors do not need a paper copy.
- Read updates for each of your college choices regarding COVID-19 it often changes!
- Stay organized and track your deadlines the California State University and the University of California application Deadline is November 30th. Private
 schools will vary so check their website and visit common application Common Application to check application deadlines and essay questions. Email
 your counselor for a google meet if we aren't back on campus.
- Work on completing your college list on Naviance and check the counseling website for college visits College and Career Center College Visits
- California State Universities application filing period open October 1st CSU Mentor: <u>California State University Video CSU Application Help | </u>



<u>Test Blind</u>: Universities will not consider any scores as part of their application review. They don't factor test scores into admissions decisions even if students submit scores.



- NO Letters of Recommendation
- Statewide student ID is on the bottom of your transcript
- UC Application
- Application help

No right or wrong way to answer, it's about getting to know your personality, background, interests, and achievements in your own unique voice




